

The Legacy Continues

Saint James AME Church-San Antonio (<https://www.saintjamesamechurch-sanantonio.org>) continues to thrive today at 402 - 410 N. Richter St., minutes away from the church's original site at San Pedro Creek. Church members remain committed to the founding principles and mission of the African Methodist Episcopal Church that resonated in the hearts and minds of the formerly enslaved Africans who founded the local church more than 156 years ago — to minister to the spiritual, social, and physical development of all people by sharing the salvific and liberating gospel of Jesus Christ.

More than 235 years ago, the founders of the African Methodist Episcopal Church affirmed their humanity in the face of enslavement and racism when they formed the Free African Society, out of which the AME Church evolved. Today, the AME Church continues to stand in defense of disadvantaged and underserved people.

Saint James is an intergenerational church just west of downtown with members representing all parts of the San Antonio Metropolitan area. Some of the ministries of Saint James include Mission and Outreach, Benevolence, Women's Bible Study, Men's Bible Study, Bible Discovery, Young Adult Praise Team, Overflow, and Spirit.

In the coming months, we anticipate reactivating the Helping Hands Ministry by partnering with the San Antonio Food Bank to distribute food to city residents, specifically persons residing in the community where the church currently sits. Before the COVID shutdown, this monthly program was instrumental in helping people affected by food insecurity. We are excited about being able to provide this service again.
